

We also seem to get ahead of ourselves with the seasons of the church year. So, for a good while discussions have been about Lent and Easter. Most are planning and "work" related but, some are more personal.

This year we began to discuss what we ought to give up for Lent. It is customary so to do every year as a helpful way to understand or participate in a small way with the suffering and anticipatory grief that Jesus must have experienced.

I suggest we listen to the Spirit for inspiring ways to help us experience the path to Jerusalem and all that follows. Then by following through with these ideas, we will experience the grief, loss, compassion and suffering of our Lord Jesus. By doing so the glory and majesty of Easter will be magnified.




