HOT ASPHALT AWARENESS

Place your hand firmly against the asphalt for 7 seconds to verify if it will be comfortable for your dog.

When the air temperature is this, asphalt has been measured at this:

Air Temp	Asphalt Temp
70°	- 125°
86°	- 135°
87°	- 143°

125° Skin destruction can occur in 60 sec.
135° An egg can fry in less than 5 min.
In 85° heat, a car can heat to 102° in 5 min.
and heat to 120° in 30 mins.
