


Church closings due to inclement weather will be announced on KMMO and a One-Call will be sent with as much notice as possible.

As we emerge from 'The Season of Asks', the Outreach Committee sends a BIG thank you to the entire congregation for all the donations of groceries, time, money, hygiene kits, Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes, Jell-O & pudding, mittens & hats, baked goods, yummy treats, your talents, and so much more!

Your efforts will help so many people and resulted in approximately \$8,300 raised from the Chili & Soup Supper and Eats, Sweets, & Treats sale. These monies will be distributed to organizations in our community that help people.

Every time the committee made an appeal, the donations poured in, and there were a lot of asks! A plan to spread the asks for items out over the year so members won't be hit with all of them at the end of the year was mentioned in an earlier "Reaching Out" article.

With that in mind, the Outreach Committee met recently and developed a plan for 2024:

- <u>February</u> Mittens, gloves, hats, socks, underwear (These items are often on sale at this time of year. Feel free to bring them into the office now or save them until the Mitten Tree goes up in November.)
- <u>February August</u> Hygiene Kit items with an emphasis on toothbrushes & paste in Feb., combs in March, shampoo in April, conditioner in May, bar soap in June, and lotion in July. Remaining needs will be announced in August.

September – Jell-O and pudding

October & November – Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes and Frozen Meal Prep

<u>Late November and December</u> – Pies, Pies, & more Pies and groceries for the Chili Super plus items for the Eats, Sweets & Treats Sale
